Stunningly convincing faux wood can be created with Polymer Clay. The imitative properties of Polymer Clay are such that with this technique the wood that is created has both the look and the feel of real wood. You will learn how to make the wood, texture for realism, and several recipes for various types of wood.

The class will focus on the process of making realistically grained and colored wood sheets. Woods such as Cherry, Walnut, Pine, and Mahogany will be made in class using easy to learn techniques. These samples will then be cut and assembled into a marquetry style tile using a few simple tools to yield an elegant result. The tile will then be yours to take with you, and with your choice of findings can be turned into a pendant or a pin.
